Dearest Family, Friends, Donors, Supporters, and Participants:

The Fraser Football Foundation, Inc. and Fraser Foundation, Ltd. are faith-based, philanthropic co-organizations operating in the United States and Jamaica with the united vision of *Changing Lives... One Goal at a Time!* and the overarching mission of improving the health, wellness, citizenship, and education of rural and inner-city children in Jamaica through football (soccer). By participating in structured, healthy activities, children are deterred from drugs, misconduct, and delinquency. Further, such activities promote health, wellness, citizenship, and education. Additionally, the children are sheltered from predatory behaviors and hostile environments.

Throughout the year, the Fraser Football Foundation collects donated football boots (cleats), apparel, and equipment in the United Stated to be distributed to needing youth in Jamaica <u>at no cost to the children</u>.

Annually, on the last Saturday of July, the Fraser Football Foundation hosts the Fraser Football Festival. The Festival includes multiple age-limited, friendly tournaments for children of all skill levels and four penalty shootout competitions for children with advanced football skills. Teams and individuals can enter events at no cost to the children! Participants of all skill levels are welcome. The event welcomes boys and girls ages 3 to 16. This year, 275 children will participate in the Fraser Football Festival 2022 at Kirkvine Sports Club in North East Manchester, Jamaica. Thanks to the generosity of our supporters and donors overseas, participating children will be provided with football boots, football jerseys, water bottles, drawstring bags, and other goodies at no cost to the children. In keeping with our commitment to education, some individual winners will receive school scholarships.

The Fraser Football Foundation is also introducing the Fraser Cup, an annual U12 football competition in primary and preparatory (elementary) schools. The Fraser Cup will be hosted in Manchester, Jamaica. Primary and preparatory school teams will be provided with some of the resources (including football boots!) needed to support afterschool football programs for children. Football boots are also available for basic schools that wish to start promoting health and wellness through football at the pre-school age.

Family, friends, donors, supporters, and participants, thank you for being a part of the *Fraser Football Festival* 2022 and for ardently helping in *Changing Lives... One Goal at a Time!*



Changing Lives... One Goal at a Time!

The Fraser Football Foundation, LLC. and Fraser Foundation, Ltd. have the united overarching vision of *Changing Lives... One Goal at a Time!* The united mission is to improve the health, wellness, citizenship, and education of rural and inner-city children in Jamaica through football. This vision and mission are being executed via three operational goals.

Goal # 1- Provide Boots for the Children

In keeping with our vision *Changing Lives... One Goal at a Time!* our **first annual goal** is to establish pathways and collect donations of football boots (cleats) for the children. Throughout the year, the Fraser Football Foundation collected donated used and new football boots to distribute to the Jamaican children at no cost to the children. This year, with the massive help of Jayar and <u>TheJoyFM</u> family and listeners, **we collected 1,217** pairs of donated new and used boots! The boots ranged from size 8½Y to size 18! The Fraser Football Foundation also accepted donations of shin guards, shorts, balls, equipment, etc.



Goal! We collected 1, 217 pairs of donated new and used football boots for the children!

Whatever is not received through the generous donations is purchased by the Fraser Football Foundation. The Fraser Football Foundation also accepts monetary donations to finance the cost of purchasing jerseys and other needed items for registered players, shipping the donations to Jamaica, tangible expenses associated with hosting the event (such as venue rental, providing water, medals, trophies, flyers), and scholarships for individual winners.

If other football items are donated and if feasible, these may be provided <u>at no cost to the players or coaches</u>, but these are not guaranteed or promised. Other items that are often donated include shin guards, bibs (pennies), cones, football bookbags, jerseys, and balls.

Goal # 2- Host a Family-Friendly Football Event for the Children

Our **second annual goal** is to host the **Fraser Football Festival**. The *Fraser Football Festival 2022* is a one-day youth football festival which includes multiple age-limited friendly tournaments for children of all skill levels. The *Fraser Football Festival 2022* also includes four shoot-out competitions for teenagers showing advanced talent. We employ the Good Sportsmanship Rule to avoid any children being embarrassed or discouraged while simultaneously providing opportunities for all children to showcase their skills. All the events are family-friendly with the focus on fun, development, citizenship, and education. Teams and players participate in the *Fraser Football Festival 2022* at no cost to them.

Goal # 3- Provide a Platform for the Children's Continued Growth

Our **third annual goal** is to host the **Fraser Cup** to support structured, healthy afterschool football activities for the children. The Fraser Cup is an annual U12 football competition in primary and preparatory (elementary) schools. The Fraser Cup will run from January through March 2023. Football boots will be provided for the children at no cost to the children.

For 2022, we aim to score a hat trick! Keep these goals in your prayers.

The Bootique

The Bootique is the Fraser Football Foundation's couture boutique at the Fraser Football Festivals featuring donated used and new boots. After check-in, players will proceed to The Bootique to receive their free boots and jerseys for the *Fraser Football Festival 2022*. Players will be fitted for their boots and jerseys to ensure the best possible fit. The Fraser Football Foundation will make every effort to provide the best possible fit for the boots, but make no guarantees.

Due to the generosity of our donors, children participating in the Fraser Football Festival 2022 will receive



a pair of football boots



a football jersey (shirt),



a drawstring football bag, and



a water bottle.



Goalkeepers will also receive goalkeeper gloves.

Bags and water bottles may be used for school. These items are given to the children and they become the owners! **THE PLAYER OWNS THE BOOTS!**

Fraser Football Festival 2022

The Geographic Reach

We had a tremendous community response to the *Fraser Football Festival 2022*! Given our location, the majority of children are from Northeast Manchester. Community teams hail from **Manchester**, **Clarendon**, **St. Mary**, and **Kingston** representing two of the three historic counties (Middlesex, and Surrey) of Jamaica. The teams hail from rural and urban areas.

The majority (223, 81%) of children are from Manchester, but we also welcome 16 (6%) children from Clarendon, 16 children (6%) from Kingston, and 20 children (7%) from St. Mary.




Figure 2: Distribution of Players by Parish

The Children

There will be **275** children playing football at the *Fraser Football Festival 2022*. The majority of children come from socioeconomic backgrounds where football boots are an unaffordable luxury. There are 232 (84%) boys and 43 (16%) girls ranging in age from 3 to 16 years old (mean = 12.8 years). The youngest girl is 8 years old and the youngest boys are only 3 years old. The huge difference in girl participation indicate a need for greater support of girls in football in Jamaica.




Figure 3: Age Distribution of Children by Gender

The children's shoe sizes range from 12Y to 12.5 (mean = 7). And every child will receive a pair of football boots! We identified that the boots sizes most needed for the boys were 7, 8, and 9; while for girls were 7 and 8.




Figure 4: Shoe Sizes by Gender




